### SHORT BIOGRAPHY

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Born in Budapest (Hungary), I attended secondary school in the Netherlands, where I won a bronze and a silver medal as the member of the national team at the International Biology Olympiad. However, my principal interest is literature, and as an undergraduate I studied Classics with Persian at Corpus Christi College, Oxford. During my postgraduate studies I turned towards Latin literature, and my research has focused on the poems of Catullus ever since I discovered an archive of valuable collations (textual notes) of the surviving manuscripts of this text from the first years of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, conserved at the Department of Classics of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. My doctoral dissertation, for which I obtained the highest qualification possible at my viva in 2009, was a new critical edition with textual commentary of one of the most difficult parts of the poetry of Catullus, the so-called *carmen* 68. I have also prepared *Catullus Online: An Online Repertory of Conjectures for Catullus* ([www.catullusonline.org](http://www.catullusonline.org)), which is the first digital repertory of conjectures and the second digital critical edition to be published for a major text from classical antiquity. I have taught and held research positions at universities including those of Munich and Barcelona, University College Dublin, Sapienza University of Rome and Eötvös Loránd University (Budapest). As of 2020, I am starting a five-year Ramón y Cajal Fellowship at the University of Barcelona.
